

BLOSSBURG BOROUGH COUNCIL
MEETING MINUTES
January 2, 2024

The Reorganizational Meeting of the Blossburg Borough Council was called to Order at 6:00 p.m. by Borough Manager, George D. Lloyd. New Members, Jill Nickerson and Joshua Jones were sworn in by Notary Public, Cheryl Bubacz.

Borough Manager accepted nominations for Council President, Jolene Hall was nominated by Kenneth Johnson and Second by Joshua Jones to appoint Jolene Hall President of the Borough Council for 2024 and 2025. All in Favor.

Council President presided over the remainder of the Meeting.

The sewer plant construction is moving along quite well. The Borough crew has been painting the inside of the buildings and are almost done.

Taylor Run has a tentative start-up date of January 22, 2024, which would be followed by DEP inspection and approval.

Motion by Jill Nickerson, Second by Joshua Jones to adopt the new Resolution for garbage rates effective January 3, 2024. All in Favor.

Blue Ridge Franchise Agreement: Under review by Solicitor at this time.

Vacant Council Seat Replacement: There were seven (7) letters received from Borough residents interested in serving the remaining 2-year term left vacant by Timothy Martin being appointed Mayor.

Nominations were opened. Jill Nickerson nominated Tonya McNamara; Robert Bowens nominated Theresa Smith and Jolene Hall nominated Kallie Wickman. A roll call vote was taken. Tonya McNamara received one vote (Jill Nickerson). Theresa Smith received two votes (Robert Bowens and Kenneth Johnson). Kallie Wickman received two votes (Joshua Jones and Jolene Hall). A second roll call vote was held between Theresa Smith and Kallie Wickman. Theresa Smith received two votes (Robert Bowens and Kenneth Johnson) and Kallie Wickman received three votes (Jill Nickerson, Jolene Hall and Joshua Jones. By majority vote, Kallie Wickman was appointed to fill the 2-year term of Timothy Martin.

President Jolene Hall swore in Kallie Wickman as Council Member.
